



## County AGRI Link Representative

### Role Description

The Agriculture & Rural Issues Steering Group (AGRI) invites counties in England and Wales to nominate a maximum of two people to act as a direct link with the Agriculture & Rural Issues Steering Group. This role description is a guide for representatives.

#### What do you need to do?

##### Agricultural Link representative:

- Pass on information on events and training sent to you by the NFYFC AGRI Officer to you County.
- Liaise with your Area AGRI representatives.
- Use social media to promote the work of AGRI by using #YFCAGRI.
- Keep in touch with agricultural developments in your county and feedback this information to your area AGRI representative.
- Discuss national committee work throughout your county and gain feedback from members.
- Assist with NFYFC research into young people and rural life.
- Attend the AGRI Forum at Annual Convention and encourage others to come with you.
- Help your fellow members to have a voice on issues that affect them by promoting the work of AGRI.
- Optional: Able to attend AGRI Steering Group as an observer if places available.

##### In return, AGRI members and staff will:

- Supply information to Link representatives on campaigns, events and training opportunities.
- Invite Link representatives to the Agri Forum at Annual Convention.
- Organise relevant training opportunities throughout the counties for members to attend.
- Assist with any research projects into young people and rural life.
- Raise funding to cover the costs of national events.
- Liaise with national organisations and Government to represent the views of young farmers.

This role plays an important part in the effectiveness of the AGRI Steering Group. However, it should be enjoyable and fulfilling for anyone who has an interest in agriculture and rural issues and who would like to work with the National Federation to help YFCs.
