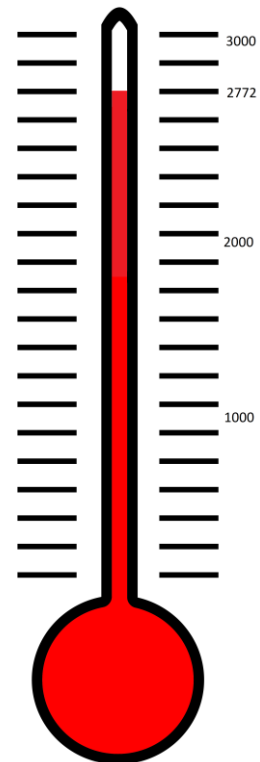

## Future Farming Curve Module Launched

In conjunction with LEAF Education, we have developed a fun and engaging session designed to help young people understand the role that agriculture has in solving global challenges as well as providing a basic understanding of where British food comes from. Aimed at year 9 learners, the agricultural project strongly supports core aims in relation to PSHE; developing critical thinking, encouraging learners to discuss and explore living in the wider world whilst encompassing economic wellbeing and aspects of agricultural, food and retail careers education.

The module has now been piloted in several schools and YFC clubs and the feedback has been very positive. The resources are now all available and can be requested from NFYFC.

## 2020 Training Courses Dates

For 2020 areas that will be eligible for support in delivering the Train the Trainer course will be:

- Northern Area
- South West Area – provisional date – 25<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> January 2020 has been requested - TBC

There is also an Advanced Train the Trainer course scheduled for 2020 if there is the demand to deliver this.

Trainers Forums (to include the Know Your Limits and Rural+ additional training) scheduled for 2020 will take place in South East Area and Eastern Area – please contact NFYFC with suggested dates.

## NFYFC Recommendations

1. All PD Steering group members to actively promote and highlight their work around training. This would include carrying out the County training recognition award in your Counties as well as encouraging them to deliver training, e.g. The Curve, Club Officer Training etc.
2. Members in the Northern Area and South West Area to liaise with their Counties / Areas to suggest potential dates and venues for their Train the Trainer courses for next year. Also promote this opportunity and encourage members to attend to increase training potential.
3. Members in the Eastern Area and South East Area to liaise with their Counties / Areas to suggest potential dates and venues for their Trainers Forums for next year. Also promote this opportunity and encourage trainers to attend.
